- Announcement of the candidate's name and give personal information about him and his family.
- Candidate information will be mailed out to all church members.

### Saturday, January 16th:

- 10:00 am - Candidate will meet with the Deacon's of the church.
- 1:00 - 3:00 pm - Candidate and his wife will give their testimonies and will be available to answer questions in the church sanctuary for all members of the church while adhering to the COVID-19 safety protocols currently in place, including social distancing and wearing masks.

### Sunday, January 17th:

- Candidate will preach during the 10:15 am worship service.
- A vote will be done by secret ballot for those members who are present in the worship service. Those who are viewing online will be able to vote by phone to the numbers given below. Church membership will be verified by the Pastor Search Committee who will be counting the votes.
- After the tabulation is complete, the church will be informed of the result.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support as we continue to seek God's wisdom in all of these decisions.

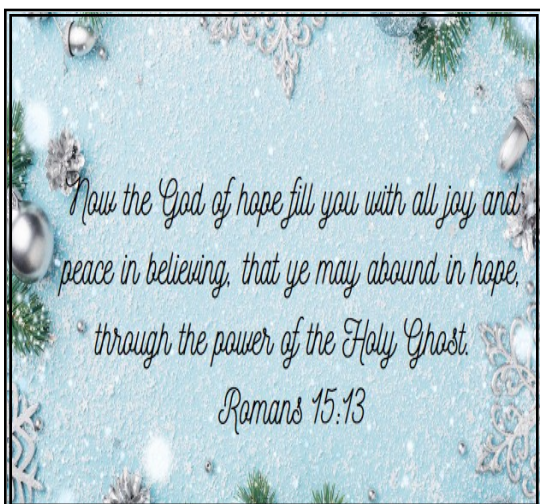
