

# Faith Family...

Hello Faith Family,

This first Sunday in May will have marked my seventh Sunday as your pastor. My family and I are getting more settled into Texas life day by day. I'm increasingly humbled at the immense privilege of being your pastor. Shiloh Terrace is a wonderful church with a rich legacy of gospel witness in East Dallas and around the world. I am confident that the Lord

desires to see Shiloh thrive as a beacon of gospel hope and transformation in the coming years.

As I work to "Define a Reality" in these first six months I'm asking the question, "What is the current situation at Shiloh?" I have learned much about Shiloh in these first weeks, and still have much more to learn. In this process, God has impressed upon me the uniqueness of our present situation as we are on the heels of a global pandemic. With things starting to open back up, people are increasingly willing to return to in-person gatherings. This presents us an incredible opportunity to help people re-engage in the life giving rhythms of the local church. If we seize this moment well, we can be even **stronger** at the end of 2021 than we were at the end of 2019.

Our strategy for seizing this opportunity is called "Face to Face." This strategy involves each one of us fulfilling four key roles:

- **COMMIT** to participating on-campus. When it is safe for you, commit to gathering every week possible.
- **REACH** out to those who are disconnected and to new people. Haven't seen someone in a while? Give them a call.
- **SERVE** on a ministry team. If we want God to send more people, we have to be ready to serve them. If you're not serving, contact the church office and we'll help you find where you fit.
- PRAY for God to transform lives. Above all else, plead with God to transform lives.
   All our work is useless unless He works.

If we are faithful and if God blesses, we can be **stronger** at the end of 2021 than we were even at the end of 2019. Being a stronger church is about much more than attendance numbers. However, attendance is a simple way to measure how engaged we are in the life of the church.

So, our goal is to be reengaged in on-campus ministry at the end of 2021 at **110**% of our engagement at the end of 2019.

Yes, this is a big task. But, we serve God who longs to see people saved and engaged in the life-giving rhythms of the local church. And this God is "able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us" (Eph. 3:20).

In the coming weeks, we will be providing more information to help you succeed in your four roles.


